Additional Clinics

Gold Coast Women and Children's Clinic (GCWCC): This clinic provides a holistic healthcare service to women and children in all stages of life and health in a caring and supportive environment. We offer a professional team of general practitioners who have special interests in all areas of women's and children's health.

PRP Clinic: PRP is an innovative treatment that stimulates the body's natural healing process that can be used to treat arthritic joint pain, knee osteoarthritis, bursitis, sports injuries, tendonitis, plantar fasciitis and more.

Cosmetic Clinic: Available to both men and women, services include anti-wrinkle injections and PRP for hair loss and skin rejuvenation.

Skin Cancer Clinic: Services include Minor Procedures, skin cancer checks, etc

Appointments with your Doctor

Please ring (07) 5557 7888 for an appointment. Every effort will be made to accommodate your preferred time and GP. Appointments are usually made at 15 minute intervals. Emergencies will always be given priority and our reception staff will attempt to contact you if there is any unforeseen delay or your GP has been called away. Longer consultation times are available so please ask our receptionists if you require some extra time.

If you or a family member require an interpreter we can organise this for you. Please let us know when you make an appointment.

Fees and Billing Arrangements

Universal bulk-billing is not financially viable and would mean this practice could not provide quality service. However, we may use bulk-billing and concession fees to aid the disadvantage, multiple family consultations or prolonged treatment programs and children under 16 years. Procedures may incur an out of pocket expense. We accept cash, EFTPOS, Mastercard and Visa credit cards.

Telephone Access

Doctors in the Medical Centre may be contacted during normal operating hours. If the doctor is with a patient, the reception staff will take a detailed message and forward this onto the doctor as soon as possible. In an emergency, your call will always be put through to either the doctor or nurse.

Parking and Disabled Access

Car parking is available onsite with separate parking bays allocated to our disabled patients.

Your Feedback, Quality and Improvement

We have a feedback form and box located on the reception desk for patients to provide feedback. We take your feedback very seriously and will try to improve on any recommendations made from our patients.

Reminders System

Our practice is committed to preventative care. Your doctor will seek your permission to be included on our reminder system. We may issue you with a reminder notice from time to time offering you preventive health services appropriate to your care, if you do not wish to be part of this system, please let your doctor know. We also participate in the State/Territory reminder system.
